


8" Finished Block



CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

Bird Body Fabric:

Cut 1 strip 2¾" x WOF.

Sub-cut from strip:

- 1 2¾" x 4" (A)
- 1 2%"x 5%" (B)
- 1 2½" x 4" (C)
- 1 2%" x 2%" (D)
- $1 2" \times 2"$ (E)
- 1 1½" x 1½" (F)

Bird Wing Fabric:

Cut 1 – 2½" x 4" (G)

Bird Legs & Beak fabric:

Cut $2 - 1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $\frac{3}{4}$ " (H)

Cut 1 – 1¼" x 1¼" (I)

Backgrounds: Assorted Fabrics


- Cut $1 1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " (J)
- Cut $1 1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ " (K)
- Cut $1 1\frac{3}{4}$ " x 4" (L)
- Cut 1 1¾" x 3¾" (M)
- Cut $1 1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $1\frac{3}{4}$ " (N)
- Cut $1 1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $1\frac{1}{4}$ " (O)
- Cut $1 1\frac{3}{4}$ " x 1" (P)
- Cut 1 1¼" x 1¼" (Q)
- Cut $1 1'' \times 6''$ (R)
- Cut 1 2½" x 2½" (S)
- Cut $1 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" (T)
- Cut $1 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{4}$ " (U)
- Cut 1 2½" x 2½" (V)

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the I square. Place in the top right corner of the N square and sew on directly on the line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam. Flip the corner back and press.





Sew the O rectangle to the top of the I/N unit. This is the beak unit.




Repeat this process with the B rectangle, V square and Q square. This is the head unit.





Repeat with the E square and T rectangle. This is the upper tail unit.







Repeat with the C rectangle and U square. This is the breast unit.






Repeat with the G rectangle, F square and D square. This is the wing unit.





Repeat with the A rectangle and the S square. This is the lower tail unit.





Sew one H rectangle to both sides of the P rectangle and press towards P.



Sew the K rectangle to the left side of the H/P/H unit and an M rectangle to the right side. Press towards K and M. This is the legs unit.






Sew the beak, head and upper tail units together. Press the seams open.

Sew the L rectangle, breast, wing and lower tail units together. Press the seams open.

Sew the top and bottom units together and add the R rectangle to the right side. Press the seams open.



Next sew the J rectangle to the top and the leg unit to the bottom.

Your bird block is complete.
