1. Join together (5) $\mathbf{2} \mathbf{1 / 2 "} \times \mathbf{8 1 / 2 "}$ rectangles of Fabric $A$. Press seams open.

2. Use a fabric pen or fabric marking tool to draw a diagonal line on the back of (4) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares of background fabric. Line each square up with a corner of the unit. Pin in place. Sew on the marked line. Trim 1/4" away from the seams. Press seams open.

3. Use a fabric pen or fabric marking tool to draw a diagonal line on the back of (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ 1/2" square and (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1$ $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square of background fabric. Line up the smaller square on the bottom right corner of the $5^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle of Fabric C, right sides together. Sew on the marked line. Trim 1/4" away from the seam. Press open.

4. Line up the larger square on the right side of the $\mathbf{5 \prime \prime} \times 2$ $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle of Fabric C, right sides together. Sew on the marked line. Trim 1/4" away from the seam. Press open.

5. Line up (1) $\mathbf{2 "}^{\prime \prime} \times \mathbf{1} \mathbf{1 / 2 "}$ rectangle of background fabric right side up on the top left corner of the rectangle of Fabric C. Use a fabric marking tool, like a Hera marker, to mark a diagonal line as shown below on both pieces of fabric. Ensure the marked line transfers through to the smaller rectangle, to the rectangle of fabric C.

6. Cut $1 / 4$ " away from the marked line on both pieces, as shown.

7. Place fabrics right sides together lining up the marked lines, as shown. Note the direction and orientation of the rectangle. Sew on marked line. Press seam open.

8. Use a fabric pen or fabric marking tool to draw a diagonal line on the back of (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square of background fabric. Line the square of background fabric on top of one (1) 1 1/2" $\times 2$ 1/2" rectangle of Fabric B right sides together. Sew on the marked line. Trim 1/4" away from the seam. Press open. 9. Use a fabric pen or fabric marking tool to draw a diagonal line on the back of (1) $11 / 4$ " $\times 11 / 4$ " square of Fabric B. Line the square of Fabric B on the top right corner of (1) 2 $1 / \mathbf{2 "}^{\prime \prime} \times 1 / \mathbf{2 "}^{\text {" }}$ square of background fabric right sides together. Sew on the marked line. Trim 1/4" away from the seam. Press open.

10. Line up (1) $13 / 4$ " $\times 1$ 1/2" rectangle of Fabric B on the top left corner of the rectangle of background fabric right side up. Use a fabric marking tool, like a Hera marker, to mark a diagonal line as shown below on both pieces of fabric. Ensure the marked line transfers through to the smaller rectangle, to the rectangle of background fabric.

11. Cut $1 / 4$ " away from the marked line on both pieces, as shown.

12. Place fabrics right sides together lining up the marked lines, as shown. Note the direction and orientation of the rectangle. Sew on marked line. Press seam open.

13. Noting the direction of the line, use a fabric pen or fabric marking tool to draw a diagonal line on the back of (1) 2 " $\times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle of Fabric B. Placing right sides together, line up the rectangle as shown with (1) 2 " $\times 1$ 1/2" rectangle of background fabric. Sew on the marked line. Trim 1/4" away from the seam. Press open.

14. Use a fabric pen or fabric marking tool to draw a diagonal line on the back of (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1$ 1/2" square of Fabric B. Line the square of Fabric B on the top of one (1) $11 / \mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime} \times$ 1 1/2" square of background fabric, sew on the marked line. Trim 1/4" away from the seam. Press open.

15. Join together the half square triangle from step 14 and the half rectangle triangle from step 13. Press seam open.

16. Join together the piece from step 15 and (1) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \mathbf{1 / 2 "}$ rectangle of background fabric. Press seam open.

17. Join together the piece from step 16 , the piece from step 12 , and the piece from step 8 . Press seams open.

18. Join together the unit you created in step 17 to the leaf you created in step 7. Press seam open.

18. Join together the unit you created in step 18 , to the pumpkin unit you created in step 2. Press seam open.

18. Join (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the left and right sides of the block. Press seams open. (For larger block sizes, see border options in chart below.

18. Join (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the top and bottom of the block. Press seams open. (For larger block sizes, see border options in chart below.)
